

## HTS COVID RULES

Please assess your student daily before sending them to the studio. If they have a fever, a runny nose, a cough, unknown rash or any other COVID symptom please keep home. We would recommend them having a Covid test, or not returning until they are symptom free. We will take each students temperature upon arrival using a no-touch thermometer. Any student with a fever or displaying concerning symptoms will have a parent or guardian called for pick up.

- 1) Masks will not be mandatory but are welcome for anyone who would like to wear one.
- 2) Extra cleaning and sanitizing of all high-touch areas, bathrooms, and seating will be done on a regular basis throughout the day.
- 3) Students are asked to hand sanitize or wash their hands as soon as they arrive at the studio. Please also wash your hands before and after using the washroom!
- 4) Sanitizer will be available in the lobby and in all the classrooms for use at any time.
- 5) Parents are asked to only come into the studio if required – just to minimize the amount of people we have in the building.
- 6) Please keep the number of items brought to the studio at a minimum such as a water bottle, dance shoes, dance wear needed for class, snacks or dinner (Please keep your items all together in a dance bag)
- 7) Parents are asked to call or email if they need to speak to staff to limit the number of people in the facility.
- 8) Dancers who sneeze or cough immediately sterilize their hands
- 9) Dancers will minimize the touching of common surface/areas

\*Anyone who has traveled out of country will be asked to stay home for the 14 day period or until a negative test result is acquired.

\*\*Acro classes may require instructor to spot or support the dancer, in this situation extra care and precaution will be taken ensuring that your child is safe and to minimize injury.

\*\*\*I understand the owner and staff of HTS will do everything possible to minimize the spread of COVID-19, but will not hold them responsible should your dancer contract COVID-19.

We know these are children- perfection is not expected! Please ensure you share these guidelines, but also explain that no one will be “in trouble” if they forget or make a mistake. We are all learning together, and we will help each other through 😊
